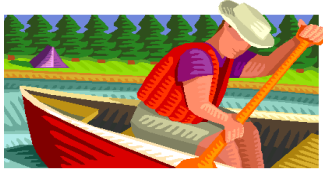
**Why:** Support Science with a Mission(SMI), bringing diagnostic testing to developing countries! \$18 of each ticket goes directly to SMI!

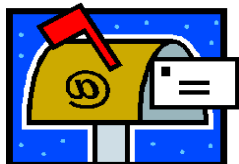
