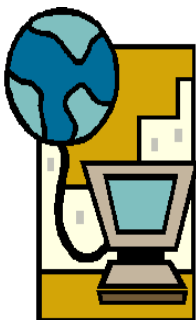


PHOTO POLICY FOR NEW WEBSITE

WORLD REFUGEE DAY: June 20, 2013

Around the world, people have been displaced, forced from their homes, or simply—fearing the worst—have fled their neighborhoods and villages ahead of waves of violence. Some people have lost the right to claim a nationality as countries and states have dissolved. Many of these people have gone to neighboring countries where they petition neighboring governments for protection and recognition as refugees.

Covenant World Relief works in partnership with the Evangelical Covenant Church of Kenya (ECCCK), in Kitengala, to provide a new home and a renewed sense of stability for Congolese refugees fleeing the violence in the Democratic Republic of Congo. Their primary focus in Kitengala is on education for the children of the refugees...

In Burma, people of the Rohingya Muslim minority were violently uprooted from their homes in June 2012 and have been living as internally displaced persons ever since, in extremely unhealthy, volatile conditions in camps near the Bangladeshi border. CWR is working in these camps, ... providing the Rohingya with basic food and water, as well as shelter and medical care.
