
#### **ONLINE GIVING**

#### SMALL GROUP MINISTRIES AT CCC

"And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day approaching." Hebrews 10:24-25

Small Group Ministries at CCC exists so that each of us would grow deeper in our relationships with Christ and each other as we learn, support, worship, serve, and pray together. Our vision is to provide a point of connection within the church and the larger community where we may grow spiritually in our faith and knowledge of Christ; be encouraged, supported, and challenged; and feel a sense of belonging and our place in the larger body of Christ. This fall, six groups will begin - we hope that you will find your point of connection!

Pertinent information about each group is listed below. Each will run from mid-September to mid-May. You can sign up on Sundays through September 15<sup>th</sup>.

Facilitator: Susan Bolinder For: adults and youth ages 12+

Location: church Day/time: Every other Saturday morning at 10am, starting September 21<sup>st</sup> This small group will be studying some of David's Psalms, with materials by author Dee Brestin. Bring your Bible and any creative materials you desire. Study pages will be provided. After our study time, we will engage our creative side and "journal" the scripture portion of the day any way you like . . . with pen and paper, scrap booking, sketching/painting - whatever you choose to depict the scripture. This *is not* an instructive class. You are encouraged to use *your* creative abilities. We will also spend time praying for and encouraging each other. I am so excited about this group.
