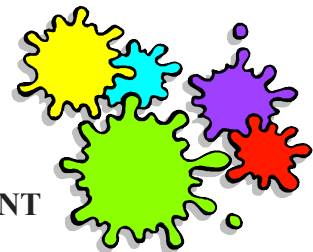

## **SPECIAL MEN'S BREAKFAST**

On Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7:30 am, there will be a special breakfast for men at our church. Dan Croce who is the chaplain for the Plymouth County Correctional Facility will be the speaker after the meal. Dan has been on both sides of the prison system. He received Christ as his Savior while behind bars of the same prison where he now serves as chaplain. During his incarceration, he studied the Bible under Chaplain Bob Hanson and was disciplined by Pastor Dennis Bauder for four years after his release. He received his BA in Bible Theology at Wheaton College and was ordained in July of 1995. In 1996, he became a full time chaplain at PCCF, the same prison where he accepted Jesus into his heart. His ministries there include preaching, pastoral counseling, teaching Bible study and coordinating services and pastoral visits. This is a faith based ministry. He is not on salary and only receives a stipend.

## **MEN'S MINISTRY SCRAP METAL DRIVE**
