Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

On Wednesday, October 8, 2015, the Leadership Team convened an emergency meeting.

The undesignated funds has fallen below \$15,000 - you may recall that the Leadership Team shared with the congregation that we had set a threshold level of \$15,000 in undesignated funds as a benchmark trigger for determining when to present suggested changes to the budget for this year (2014) to make expense cuts as necessary. We have been reviewing the financials on an ongoing basis, and have already made some adjustments during the past couple months that did not affect the quality of our ministry (such as changing from cream colored paper to white paper for the SYK and Bulletin, and cutting back on our cleaning service).

As a result of the meeting last night, the Leadership Team will be presenting a list of suggested cuts for congregational approval that could be taken if the regular Sunday giving to the general operating budget continues to fall below what is needed to meet our expenses. This would mean calling a special Congregational Meeting. Our by-laws require that we give 2 weeks' notice which brings us very close to the Congregational Meeting scheduled for November 2<sup>nd</sup>, so we will present the list at that time.
