January '07 marked a new chapter for Phil after announcing he would be stepping out of the band after thirteen years to focus on his growing desire for more hands on ministry.

Over the last 5 years, he's had the opportunity to perform, speak and lead worship with ministries such as Focus on the Family, Winter Jam, Acquire The Fire, Harvest Crusades, Men At The Cross and many churches throughout the US, Canada, New Zealand and Australia.

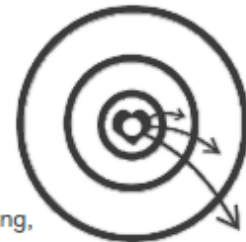


### THE MESSAGE

In 2005, Phil and his wife Heather began **deliberatePeople** - a ministry focused on communicating God's desire for us to live in true relationship - **first with Him** and then with those around us.

A "deliberate person" is one that passionately pursues their personal, one-on-one relationship with the Lord everyday and is allowing that **PRIMARY RELATIONSHIP** to permeate all areas of their life:
