Many thanks to all of you who support this outreach by providing gift items, financial support, words of encouragement and prayer. My records show that Esther Garland and I made the first deliveries on July 15, 2008: Esther, Mabel and I now make the deliveries. As we begin our seventh (!) year, it is time to give other members of the church family opportunities to become involved. I am uncertain how we will proceed with this, but if you have any interest in helping with deliveries (possibly in teams visiting fewer homes about once every other month), helping maintain the data base, mapping the delivery routes or even following up with further outreach to those who might welcome it, please talk with Mabel, Esther or myself.
