Christmas Wreath Sale

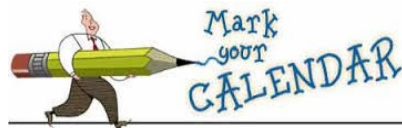


Again this year our youth will be selling decorated Christmas wreaths to raise funds for their 2018 Covenant High In Christ event.
