to the East Bridgewater church community for your continued support of CYAK! We are so grateful for the church partnership that continues to believe in, pray for and invest in the mission of Christ in Alaska.

There are many wonderful things to report this year.

- High school and junior high Fall Blast retreats saw a 32% increase in student participation from 57 to 84 students.
- Staff compiled 75 names of young Alaskans who show leadership skills or potential. Well above Byron's goal of '30 under 30.'
- Scammon Bay youth group has doubled in size in 2017.
- CYAK hosted the largest 'Would Jesus Eat Frybread' conference to date this fall in partnership with CRU and CHI Alpha, with 250 students representing over 30 native tribes across the country in attendance.
- Major grant partnerships from Rasmuson Foundation and Murdock Trust bring us near the end of our capital campaign goal of purchasing and renovating two Aarigaa house facilities.
