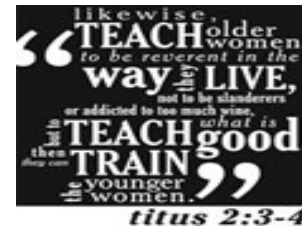

Oscar and Amy's love for the LORD Jesus Christ called them to this ministry which has been life changing for so many boys, girls and anyone who has been blessed to work with them in any capacity.
