It will be a simple meaningful service... A time to be with God and seek His will as we move toward Holy week.

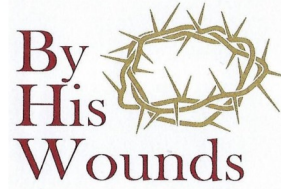
If you can't make it out at night, you can join us during the daylight hours... during our normal Wednesday Prayer and Bible Study time from 10:30-11:30 AM
