Community Covenant Church Lent 2025 Week 2

<u>Introduction</u>

As the Israelites journeyed through the wilderness, God continued to form His people. Teaching them that they could trust Him for He is good. They could obey his commands for they lead to life. God got them out of Egypt... now He was trying to get Egypt out of them. There were old things they had to let go of and new things they had to grab ahold of. There were old Egyptian gods (i.e, the golden calf). Old Egyptian ways of looking at the world (world view) and old "ways of life" (habits). If they were ever going to become the people they were called to be and enter the promised land, they would have to learn to trust God... put their whole confidence in Him and by faith.

The Plan

Last week, we focused on the first Temptation of Christ and asked what we need to give up. (Repentance). This week, we will focus on the first temptation and ask what we must take in (Receive).
