

Community Covenant Church Lent 2025 Week 3

Introduction

This week, we focus on the second temptation of Christ and ask, "What do we need to give up?" (Repentance). This week in our passage, Satan tempts Jesus to test the Father. The Israelites also tested God in the wilderness. We will explore what it means to test God.

This Week

- Read the passages below. Ask questions and discuss their significance.
- Read and meditate on Matthew 4:5-7
- ⇒ What do you notice? Share your observations
- ⇒ What do you make of the temptation?
- ⇒ What do you make of Jesus' reply?
- Satan quotes **Psalm 91:11**. Read the Whole Psalm to get the context.
- Jesus quotes **Deuteronomy 6:16**. Read Deuteronomy 6:1-19 to get the context.
- Compare and contrast how Satan treats scripture and How Jesus treats scripture.
- Jesus' reply references the Israelites testing God in the wilderness at Massah.
- Read the accounts in **Exodus 17:1-7** & amp; **Deuteronomy 9:22**.
- ⇒ How did they test God? Share your observations.
- What points of application can we make?
