Community Covenant Church Lent 2025 Week 4

Introduction

During Christ's 40 days in the wilderness, he was tested by Satan. During Israel's 40 years in the wilderness, they were tested by God. Both tests revealed what was in the heart of the one tested. In Deuteronomy 8, we read that God tested the Israelites in the wilderness to humble them and test them to know what was in their heart, to see whether they would keep his commands. Verse 7 says, "Know then in your heart that as a man disciplines his son, so the Lord your God disciplines you". At the heart of discipline is training. As athletes discipline their bodies for an event, God disciplines us for life in godliness. We often call this training. Training involves teaching, coaching, modeling, and strengthening for a specific purpose.

Scripture plays a major role in our discipleship. We see how Jesus uses it to shut down Satan. Paul writes to Timothy to encourage him to know, apply and use the scriptures in ministry. 2 Timothy 3:16, "All Scripture is God breathed and useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

This Week

This week, we will focus on God's testing of us.

Read the passages below. Ask guestions and discuss their significance.

- 1. Read and meditate on Matthew 4:5-7. What did Jesus' test in the wilderness reveal about Him? What did the Israelites' tests reveal about them?
- 2. Trials and Tests are a part of the Christian life. Read and meditate on James 1:2-8, 1 Peter 1:6-7, Hebrew 12:7-13

What do you notice? Share your observations

What is the purpose of trials/tests?

How should we approach them?

What can we learn from them? In Them?

What do we need to grab hold of? (Receive)

During Lent, we often practice the spiritual discipline of fasting. How can fasting help us in following Christ?

*If you have more time, read 1 Corinthians 9:24-27, 10:1-13.

What points of application can we make?

Close in the prayer together.


