Week 6

Introduction

We will look at the third temptation again this last week of Lent and compare it to the Israelites' idolatry in the wilderness. Last week, we asked what we needed to let go of. This week, we ask, what do I need to grab ahold of? (Receive)

1. Read and meditate on Matthew 4:8-11.

Hypothetical: If we were the one Satan was tempting, why might we be tempted to fall for it?

2. Read the Story about the Golden Calf in Exodus 32:1-35

What can we learn from this Story? Share your observations and questions.

Why does humanity seem to gravitate toward the sin of idolatry?

How can the Gospel protect us from falling into the sin of idolatry?

What is the significance of The Great Commandment in light of idolatry? Matthew 22:36-37 (NIV) "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.'

What points of application can we make?

What do we need to grab ahold of?
