This year the children who participated at Vacation Bible School raised enough money to ship 150 boxes. We are so thankful for these donations. We hope this will defray the cost of preparing your shoeboxes and maybe we can hit 150 boxes this year.

The list of items that you **should not** include in your boxes this year are as follows: Soap, Candy, toothpaste, gum, used or damaged items, scary or war related items, seeds, food, liquids or lotions, medications or vitamins, breakable items or glass containers or aerosol cans.

"SHOEBOX FILLER DAY" what does that mean? We have leftover items from last years packing party that will be displayed in the gym after church on **October 19th**. We have 150 OCC boxes available to fill. You will be able to fill as many boxes as you wish to take with the items displayed. We will have girls dresses, pencil cases, toothbrushes, notebooks, stuffed animals, games and many other miscellaneous items.

You may not be able to fully fill your box but it will surely help. I am hoping you will set this time aside to get started on your shoeboxes.
